

This course satisfies the Remedial Driving Course Requirements for license reinstatement by teaching the West Central Ohio Safety Council & National Safety Council Defensive Drive Course (DDC-6/8)

In order to have driving privileges reinstated an individual may be required to:

- Complete a remedial driving course
- File FRA Insurance.
- Remit any applicable reinstatement fees.
- Retake a complete driver license examination including the written and road test.

Mail requirements to: Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles P O Box 16520, Columbus, OH 43266-0020.

A twelve point suspension results when a driver accumulates 12 points on his/her driving record within a two-year period.

This course also meets the requirements for an individual who wishes to get a 2-point credit.
