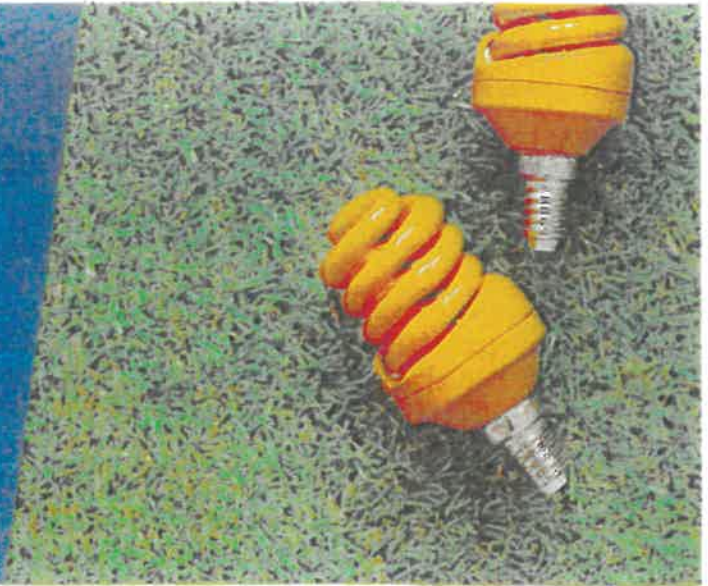

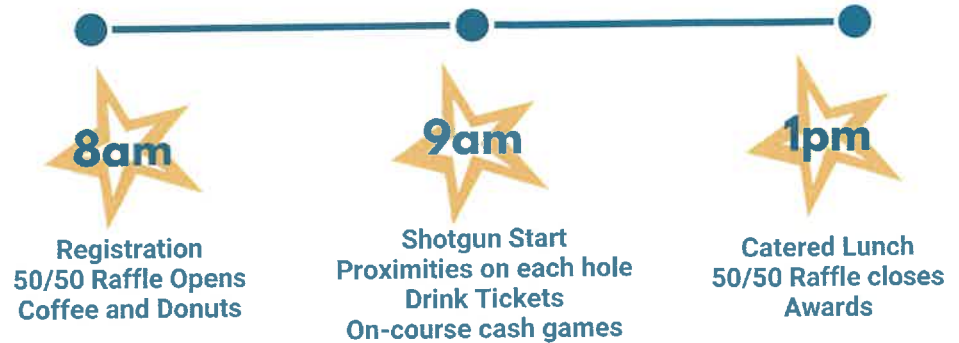

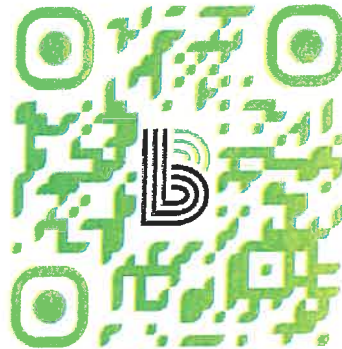

Big Brothers Big Sisters of West Central Ohio to Host Mental Health Awareness Event in Putnam County

Putnam County, OH — In recognition of Mental Health Awareness Month, Big Brothers Big Sisters of West Central Ohio, Inc. (BBBSWCO) will host a community-focused Mental Health Awareness Event on Friday, May 15, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Putnam County Educational Service Center in Putnam County, Ohio. This year's event, titled "Big Feelings. Real Tools. Lasting Change. – Bridging SEL & EFT Tapping," will bring together mental health professionals, educators, youth-serving organizations, and community members to explore practical strategies that support youth mental health and emotional well-being.

The event is made possible through the generous support of key community partners, including Buckeye Health Plan of Ohio and CareSource, whose commitment to improving health outcomes continues to strengthen communities across the region.

Building on the success of last year's event in Lima, where BBBSWCO collaborated with CASA/Crime Victims Services and the Ohio Department of Youth Services to bring nationally recognized speaker Seth Gehle, this year's event expands into Putnam County as part of a broader initiative to bring mental health awareness programming across the organization's full-service area.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of West Central Ohio serves youth and families across Allen, Hancock, Hardin, Paulding, Putnam, and Van Wert Counties, and plans to rotate this mental health awareness series throughout its six-county region to ensure greater accessibility and community impact.

The featured speaker for the 2026 event is Melissa Schroeder, a former BBBSWCO staff member and mentor - Alumni Big. Schroeder is also the author of the *Princess Patty and Prince Patrick* children's book series, developed in collaboration with her former Little, Mariah Dunbar, who illustrated the series.

During the event, Schroeder will share her personal mentoring journey and lead a dynamic presentation on Emotional Freedom Techniques (EFT Tapping), an evidence-informed approach to emotional regulation. Attendees will gain insight into the science behind EFT tapping, its
